

**Flight of Dreams 2014** is a collaboration between <u>Princess Vlei Forum</u>, Frank Joubert Art Centre and The Children's Art Centre. Our event last year was so successful we have decided to repeat it on a larger scale.

The programme aims to:

- raise awareness about environmental issues, in particular about the importance of conserving and rehabilitating Princess Vlei.
- celebrate the natural systems and flora and fauna existing within our urban context, in particular the birds
- enable children to express their appreciation of nature through creative projects.

The programme will incorporate a series of workshops culminating in an **evening parade at Princess Vlei on 27**<sup>th</sup> **September**. The parade will feature bird masks and puppets, performances and musical instruments created by the children.

The following events have so far been proposed as part of this project:

- 1. A 'birdathon' to monitor and observe the birds at Princess Vlei.
- 4. Workshops to create bird puppets, and musical instruments, and to work towards a performance element for the parade.
- 5. **27 September:** An evening parade through the streets, around Princess Vlei and finishing at the Jolly Carp (route still to be determined.)

We are also exploring the possibility of an exhibition at Kirstenbosch later in the year, and involvement in the Muizenberg Festival in October.
